Operating Budget

GCRTA BRIDGE & STRUCTURE SUMMARY.

GCRTA owns 100 bridges, including:

- 66 transit track bridges
- 5 public highway bridges
- 6 private road bridges
- 11 pedestrian bridges
- 3 platform bridges (W. 117, Cedar–University, Superior)
- 9 inactive bridges

GCRTA owns seven structures that are not classified as bridges, including:

- Brookpark Pedestrian Passageway
- Airport & Berea Tunnel
- Mechanically Stabilized Earth (MSE) walls
- Norfolk Southern culvert
- S-Curve retaining walls
- Tower City East portals
- Old Puritas accessway

In addition, a total of 82 bridges cross GCRTA rail lines and are owned by Bedrock, City of Cleveland, the Ohio

Department of Transportation (ODOT), Cuyahoga County, Norfolk Southern, CSX, and various private entities
